COVID-19 - Impact on LISS/CSCS applications

23 March 2020

The growing concerns surrounding Coronavirus (COVID-19) are likely to impact CSCS's ability to issue LISS/CSCS cards to some first-time applicants or those wishing to renew their card prior to expiry.

BALI validate all LISS/CSCS applications then these are sent to CSCS to generate your card therefore please visit the CSCS website for regular updates. A key requirement for all applications (new or renewal) is proof that the applicant has passed the relevant CITB Health, safety and environment (HS&E) test within the last 2 years, please click [here](#) to find the latest update from CSCS.

In addition, for the majority of LISS/CSCS card applications it is also a mandatory requirement to have completed the ROLO Health, Safety and Awareness Course. Please click [here](#) for further details on the current situation.

Keep informed

CSCS will continue to monitor the situation and where necessary introduce further proactive measures to limit the impact on CSCS and LISS/CSCS applicants and the wider industry.
