JOB ROLE & TIMELINE

January	Debrief meeting held virtually, lasting approximately 2 hours to cover feedback on previous year’s Awards, as well as setting timelines and expectations for the year ahead.
June	Allocation of approximately 20 entries by Events Project Manager with agreement from all Judges, taking into consideration any conflicts of interest.
July/August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Desktop review of allocated entries, taking approximately 3 hours per entry with approximately 20 entries to judge. • Reports to be completed. • Feedback uploaded to online judging platform.
December	National Landscape Awards ceremony.
